Family Reconciliation Program

The Family Reconciliation Program provides assistance to young people at risk of becoming homeless or experiencing homelessness to resolve conflicts and re-establish relationships with their families and other important people in their life through mediation and support.

Are You?

- 15 – 21 years of age
- At risk of homelessness due to family conflict in the home or homeless due to conflict in the home

We Provide

- Formal mediation to young person/parent or carer
- Support to reconcile with family/carers
- Referrals to other support services as needed

Who Can Access the Program

- Youth and their families that reside in Mildura
- Relatives or friends who are concerned about a young person becoming homeless
- Workers from agencies who are seeking information or advice

Outcomes

- Assist young people and parent/caregivers to resolve conflict and build positive relationships
- Assist young people who have left home to re-establish supportive relationships with their families to return home
- Provide support to access services – counselling, housing and housing services, education and vocational training, and Centrelink services.
