# Our Services and Programs

## **Family Safety**

Family violence is a critical issue across our communities. MASP's Family Safety programs focus on creating safe environments for families. We offer crisis accommodation, domestic violence support, and counselling services. We aim to provide avenues and support to those experiencing or at risk of, family violence.

In our Homelessness Support program, MASP provides emergency housing, outreach support, and assistance finding stable housing solutions.

# **Children, Youth & Families**
